

LOMA LINDA UNIVERSITY (LLU), STUDENT LOAN ACCOUNTS OFFICE INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO APPLY FOR RESIDENCY DEFERMENT ON CERTAIN LLU PRIVATE CAMPUS-BASED STUDENT LOANS

ATTENTION DENTAL STUDENTS, THESE RESIDENCY DEFERMENT INSTRUCTIONS SHOULD ONLY BE FOLLOWED IF YOU ARE DOING A RESIDENCY OUTSIDE OF LLU

Instructions

To request residency deferment on your LLU private campus-based student loan(s) you must submit a written residency deferment letter written by your House Staff/Graduate Medical Education Director's office to the LLU Student Loan Accounts Office, annually or 30 days prior to the end of your grace period, deferment, or payment due date whichever occurs first.

Ask your House Staff/Graduate Medical Education Director's office to write a letter on their letterhead or provide certification that includes the information listed below.

1. Date
2. Your name
3. The last 4 of your Social Security Number or Heartland ECSI account number
4. Type of residency program
5. The beginning and ending dates of your residency
6. Letter must be written on Hospital/Institution letterhead or have Hospital/Institution Stamp or Seal
7. Printed Name & Signature of House Staff/Graduate Medical Education Director

Additional Information you should know about

It will be your responsibility to follow up on your deferment and loan status by contacting or logging onto your account with Heartland ECSI. Principal and interest may be deferred for the length of residency during **continuous** residency on certain LLU private campus-based student loan(s). (Please refer to your promissory note terms). LLU private campus-based student loans **DO NOT HAVE FELLOWSHIP DEFERMENT PROVISIONS**; therefore, you will need to make payments during fellowship.

After the residency deferment ends or after you complete residency (whichever occurs first), regular monthly payments will resume or start (there is no additional grace period).

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
